Instructions for Eligible Candidates Appearing in the Computer Based Test (CBT)

Post: Assistant Professor (Veterinary, Dairy and Fisheries Faculties)

All eligible candidates are required to carefully read and strictly follow the instructions given below for appearing in the Computer Based Test (CBT).

1. Reporting Time

- Candidates must report at the Examination Centre strictly as per the reporting time mentioned on the Admit Card.
- Late entry will not be permitted under any circumstances.
- Candidates are advised to reach the venue well in advance to complete verification and seating formalities smoothly.

2. Examination Centre (Scan QR Code)

3. Documents to be Brought (Mandatory)

Every candidate must bring the following:

1. **Printed Hard Copy of the Admit Card** (downloaded from the Recruitment Portal).
2. **One Original Photo Identity Proof** (any one of the following):

- Aadhaar Card
- Driving Licence

3. **One Recent Color Passport Size Photograph** (same or similar to the one uploaded in the application form).

Failure to produce any of the above documents will result in denial of entry to the examination hall.

4. Prohibited Items

The following items are strictly prohibited inside the examination hall:

- Mobile phones
- Smart watches
- Bluetooth devices
- Earphones or headphones
- Calculators
- Pen drives
- Digital diaries
- Any electronic or communication device
- Study material, papers, notes, or books

If any candidate is found carrying or using prohibited items, appropriate action will be taken as per University rules, including cancellation of candidature.

5. Examination Conduct and Decorum

- Candidates must maintain complete discipline and decorum inside the examination centre.
- Follow the instructions of the invigilators and technical staff at all times.
- Do not engage in any unfair practice or misconduct.
- Do not attempt to communicate with other candidates during the examination.
- Any attempt to disturb the examination process will lead to strict disciplinary action.

6. CBT Process and Guidelines

- The Computer Based Test will be conducted in online mode.

- The test will consist of 100 Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs).
- Each question carries 1 mark.
- There is no negative marking.
- Detailed instructions regarding login procedure, answering pattern, navigation between questions, submission process, and technical guidance will be explained at the Examination Centre before commencement of the test.
- Candidates are advised to carefully listen to the instructions provided by the technical team at the venue.

7. General Instructions

- Seating arrangement will be allotted at the time of examination.
- Rough sheets, if permitted, will be provided at the centre and must be returned after completion of the test.
- Candidates must sign the attendance sheet and complete all verification formalities as instructed.
- Once the examination begins, candidates will not be allowed to leave the hall until completion of the test, except under exceptional circumstances with permission.

All candidates are advised to cooperate with the University authorities to ensure smooth and fair conduct of the Computer Based Test.
